TEMPORARY USE PERMIT IS APPROVED BY NDWR. THE COUNTY'S CURRENT PERMIT #60964 PROVIDES THE COUNTY WITH 695.01 AC-FT. PER YEAR FROM THIS LOCATION. IF MRG PUMPS THE MAXIMUM REQUESTED, THE COUNTY'S BALANCE WOULD STILL BE 656.34 AC-FT. MRG WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYMENT OF ALL FEES ASSOCIATED WITH THE CHANGE OF USE APPLICATION.
