1 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that a copy of this Order and verified application for
2 protection order shall be transmitted forthwith together with the verified Application and
3 supporting Affidavit, to the applicable Sheriff's Office, or Constable, who will promptly attempt
4 to serve the same upon the Adverse Party, and upon service, file return of service form with the
5 court.

6 **VIOLATION OF THIS ORDER IS A CRIME**

7 **You, the Adverse Part, are notified that you can be arrested for violating this order.**
8 You can be arrested even if the person who obtained this Order invites or allows you to contact
9 him or her. You have the sole responsibility to avoid or refrain from violating the terms of this
10 Order. A violation includes but is not limited to contact in the form of verbal, electronic, and
11 social media communications.

12 **You are further notified of the penalty for violation of an order. A person who**
13 **intentionally violates:** an extended order is guilty of a category C felony which is punishable
14 by imprisonment in the state prison for not more than 5 years, and a fine of not more than
15 \$10,000.00. (NRS 200.378.) Each act that constitutes a violation of the extended order may be
16 prosecuted as a separate violation of this order.

17 **IF YOU ARE ARRESTED FOR VIOLATING THIS ORDER** you will not be admitted
18 to bail sooner than 12 hours after your arrest if:

- 19 (1) the arresting officer determines that the violation is accompanied by a direct or indirect
20 threat of harm; or
21 (2) you have previously violated a temporary or extended order for protection of the type for
22 which you have been arrested; or
23 (3) at the time of the violation or within 2 hours after the violation, you have:
24 (I) a concentration of alcohol of 0.08 or more in your blood or breath; or
25 (II) an amount of a prohibited substance in your blood or urine that is equal to or greater
26 than the amount set forth in subsection 3 or 4 of NRS 484C.110.

27 Under federal law, this protection order is valid and enforceable in all 50 states, the District of
28 Columbia, U.S. Territories, and Indian Nations (18 USC § 2265.)

Only the court can change this order.

ORDER TO LAW ENFORCEMENT

1 Any law enforcement officer, with or without a warrant, may arrest and take into
2 custody the Adverse Party, when the law enforcement officer has probable cause to
3 believe that (a) an Order has been issued pursuant to NRS 33.400 against the Adverse
4 Party; (b) the Adverse Party has been served with a copy of the Order; and (c) the
5 Adverse Party is acting or has acted in violation of the Order. This arrest may occur
6 regardless of whether the violation occurred in the officer’s presence.

7 Any law enforcement agency in this state may enforce a Court Order issued
8 pursuant to NRS 33.400 without regard to the county in which the Order is issued.
