3 Any law enforcement officer, with or without a warrant, may arrest and take into
4 custody the Adverse Party, when the law enforcement officer has probable cause to
5 believe that (a) an Order has been issued pursuant to NRS 200.378 against the Adverse
6 Party; (b) the Adverse Party has been served with a copy of the Order; and (c) the
7 Adverse Party is acting or has acted in violation of the Order. This arrest may occur
8 regardless of whether the violation occurred in the officer's presence.

9 Any law enforcement agency in this state may enforce a Court Order issued
10 pursuant to NRS 200.378 without regard to the county in which the Order is issued.
